What Happened

In August 2021, Hurricane Ida struck Louisiana, becoming one of the most powerful storms to hit the United States. This devastating Category 4 hurricane made landfall near Port Fourchon, Louisiana, causing catastrophic damage across the region. The hurricane brought with it sustained winds of 150 mph, torrential rainfall, tornadoes, and life-threatening storm surges, crippling both Mississippi's and Louisiana's power grids. The aftermath of the storm left more than a million customers, including all of New Orleans, without electricity during the sweltering heat of late summer.
